Memory Verses for December of 2022

Memory work includes the reference spoken before and after the actual verse. Third grade and above should aim to memorize all five verses each month. Grades One and Two should aim to memorize three of the verses each month. Each child will recite his or her verses for an assigned adult. The adult will award prizes if the child has memorized the verses. Children should also be encouraged to find these verses in their own Bibles.

Isaiah 9:6 — “For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.” — **Isaiah 9:6**

Micah 5:2 — “But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, though you are small among the clans of Judah, out of you will come for me one who will be ruler over Israel, whose origins are from of old, from ancient times.” — **Micah 5:2**

Luke 1:30-31 — “But the angel said to her, ‘Do not be afraid, Mary, you have found favor with God. You will be with child and give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus.’” — **Luke 1:30-31**
